Contents Requirement

By Assignments

Last Assignment (if applicable)

- Description
 - The last assignment that the students were required to submit
- Contents of Interest
 - When this assignment was due
 - Assignment average
 - For the entire course
 - By Section
 - By Grader
 - Histogram of mark distribution
 - Histogram of the number of grace days used (if applicable)
 - Percent submission (i.e., the percent of the entire class that submitted an assignment)

Current Assignment

- Description
 - The assignment that is due next
- Contents of Interest
 - When this assignment will be due
 - Grader distribution (by groups and/or by rubric elements)
 - Summary of the marking scheme
 - Submission progress (i.e., the number of assignments that have been submitted thus far)
 - This can be broken down further into the number of submissions for every required file specified in the assignment properties.
 - Grading progress (i.e., the number of assignments that have been graded thus far)
 - This can be broken down further into the grading progress of each grader.

Next Assignment (if applicable)

- Description
 - The assignment that is due after the current assignment
- Contents of Interest
 - When this assignment will be due
 - Assignment Management Checklist:
 - Has a marking scheme already been specified?
 - Have graders been assigned to every group?

Other Features & Technicalities

- Each content header will be linked to the full view corresponding to the feature being represented. For example, if the user clicks on a header named "Marking Scheme Summary", MarkUs will load the marking scheme page for that assignment.
- Another possible way of arranging the Dashboard contents is by feature. For example, there may be a "Histograms" section that shows the mark distribution for the last n assignments. This is different from the "By Assignments" breakdown mentioned above because the "By Assignments" approach loads different types of data for assignments based on whether or not the assignment has passed its deadline.
